

Dear Lake Charter Township Voter:

Thank you for being a registered voter in Lake Charter Township.

This letter is to let you know that as a voter, at the age of 60 you are eligible to be added to our permanent absentee voter list.

If you choose to be added, you will automatically receive an "Application for Absent Voter Ballot" approximately 45 to 50 days before EVERY upcoming election. This can serve one of two purposes:

- You can complete the Application for Absent Voter Ballot and receive your ballot by mail, or
- The Application may simply serve as a reminder of an upcoming election.

Once you are on this list, you need not sign up to be on it again. All you will need to do is fill out the application and return it either in person, via the blue drop box out front of the old fire station, or by mail, to Lake Charter Township Hall, P.O. Box 818, 3220 Shawnee Road, Bridgman, Michigan 49106. Upon receiving your completed application, you will be issued a ballot which may be filled out in our office, or in the privacy of your home and mailed back to the Township Hall.

If you do not return your application, you will not receive a ballot for the upcoming election. In this case you may simply vote in person on election day, as you always have.

Would you like to be added to the permanent voter list? If yes, please sign in the box below, return this letter to Lake Charter Township Hall, P.O. Box 818, 3220 Shawnee, Bridgman, MI 49106. If no, then you need to do NOTHING and you will continue to vote in person as you always have.
