### Lake Township Curbside Recycling Program

Lake Township has gotten many inquiries and requests for enhanced recycling programs for its residents. Your Township Board is considering adding a curbside recycling program to your existing trash service costs but they need your input. Please let the township know if you would participate in a curbside recycling program if offered.

- **Single Stream** or **"All in One"** Recycling would be picked up curbside in 96 gallon carts.
- Program would start on April 1, 2016.
- Refer to the back of this page to review acceptable items for recycling.
- If the program were adopted, the current recycling containers provided by the township would be removed.

#### Review & Benefits of 96 gallon cart collection (proposed program)

- This is now the preferred method of recycling collection in the industry.
- Service would be provided Every Other Week (26 pick-ups per year).
- Each resident would receive a 96 gallon lidded cart with wheels. The lids will help curb blowing material and scavenging by animals which will enhance the cleanliness of the city and its neighborhoods. Also, wheeled carts are easy to place at the curb and provide stability while being rolled out, especially in inclement weather.
- You could expect up to a 70% increase in recycling volume which will reduce the amount of trash going into our landfills and enhance the township's visibility toward its sustainability goals.
- No sorting of materials.
- Using a "Single Stream" collection method the drivers can utilize an automated collection truck which will maximize operational efficiencies.
- An enhanced education program in partnership with the township will help drive the success of the new program.
- The purchase of carts and equipment represents a significant investment in your community by Republic Services.
